

# 2020 President's Cup

## Saturday, October 24 – First Round - Tee Times (9:00 -10:30 am) --- Breakfast and Lunch Provided

**Shamble/Four-Ball Match Play** – In the shamble four-ball match play, both players on a side will tee off and select their best drive. Each player can move the ball one grip length, no nearer to the hole, and then proceed to play their own ball the remainder of the hole. The lowest score between partners will count for the team and be used for the match against their opponents. Each player will receive 70% of their total handicap, and the player with the lowest handicap will play as a 0. The remaining players will receive their allocated strokes based on the difference. One point will be awarded for the front 9, one point for the back 9, and one point for the 18-hole match result. Scorecards will be marked accordingly. Ties will be split with each team receiving ½ point.

## Saturday, October 24 – Second Round - Tee Times (1:30 -3:00 pm)

**Foursomes Match Play (9 Holes)** - After Saturday mornings four-ball match, all teams will compete in a Ryder Cup style alternate shot format against the same opponents from the morning match. In Foursomes Match Play, two players play against two and each side plays one ball. The partners alternate who hits on the teeing ground in addition to the play of the hole. For example, if Player A tees off on hole 1, Player B will hit the second shot. Player B will then tee off on hole 2 and so on. Handicap strokes will be determined by combined team handicap. The team with the lower handicap will play to 0, and the higher handicapped team will play to 50% of the difference. Scorecards will be marked. Each match is worth one point for the team total. Ties will be split with each team receiving ½ point.

## Sunday, October 25 – Third Round - Tee Times (10:00 -11:30 am)

**Four-Ball Match Play** – In four-ball match play, two players on one side will play their better ball against the better ball of the other two players. The player in the foursome with the lowest handicap will play at 0 and the other players will have their handicaps reduced by an equal number of strokes. Each of the three other players will be handicapped at 100% of the difference. One point will be awarded for the front 9, one point for the back nine, and one point for the 18-hole match result. Scorecards will be marked. Ties will be split with each team receiving ½ point.
